The Broome County Firefighters' Association will hold the seventh annual Broome County Fire Expo - EXPO 2010 - on Saturday, September 11, from 10 am to 4 pm at the Port Crane Fire Station, Route 369, Port Crane, New York. The fire station is located 3.5 miles off Exit 3 of Route I-88, across from the entrance to Chenango Valley State Park.

Vendors who offer products of interest to the fire and emergency services are invited to participate. Space will be limited so if you are interested in participating we suggest that you get your reservation in right away.

Last year 30 vendors participated and hundreds of attendees came from all over Central New York and Northern Pennsylvania. We will again be sending out information to fire companies in Broome, Tioga, Cortland, Chenango, Otsego, Sullivan, Delaware, Chemung and Tompkins Counties in New York and Tioga, Wayne, Susquehanna and Bradford Counties in Pennsylvania.

In addition to vendor displays there will be displays by local emergency services organizations. This year's Expo will also feature a 9/11/01 Memorial Service at 1 pm.

INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. Inside Space: The Exhibitor is responsible for setup and cleanup and for bringing in tables, chairs, signs, and all other display materials. The display fee only provides space for the exhibitor. A limited number of tables will be available for rental but arrangements must be made in advance.**
- 2. Vendor is responsible for setup and cleanup. Any broken glass, oil, fuel, or other leaks or spills from vehicles or equipment or other debris must be cleaned up by the exhibitor.**
- 3. Setup/Take-down: Expo hours are 10 AM to 4 PM. Exhibitors may setup starting at 8 AM. All booths must be setup by 10 AM. Take-down: All exhibitors must be cleaned up and out by 5:00 PM on Saturday unless other arrangements have been made.**
- 4. All exhibitors must only use the space allotted to them and may not use aisles or other unoccupied areas nor infringe on the space of other exhibitors.**
- 5. Music or any displays with sound must be kept to a low enough volume so as not to disrupt activities of other exhibitors.**
- 6. Electricity is available for those who need it but you should bring a 100 foot extension cord to ensure that you are able to get electricity to your booth.**
- 7. Exhibitor is responsible for setup, take-down and cleanup up of their area.**
- 8. The Fire Expo is primarily aimed at fire and emergency services agencies. We reserve the right to reject any exhibitor whose products or services are not appropriate for this Expo.**
- 9. In addition to exhibitors there will be displays by Broome County Emergency Services, bomb squad, haz mat team, and other emergency services related agencies.**
- 10. The Expo will be held regardless of the weather.**
- 11. An exhibitor may cancel up until September 1, 2010. After September 1, 2010, no refunds will be given.**
