At a fire that was started by a tramp in sheds connected with the First Baptist church, Frank J. Hehar, a member of the Rockbottom Fire Company, was killed instantly. Timbers fell on him and two other firemen, Michael Casey and Peter Sincale(?). They escaped without serious injury.

FF. Hahar was killed while fighting a large barn fire on Warren St. in downtown Binghamton. FF. Hahar was the first Binghamton firefighter killed in the line-of-duty. He worked out of the Rockbottom Hose Co. and had been a firefighter for only 3 months. He was 21 years old.
