The Chapter is currently seeking nominations for this special event, which was conceived to recognize people in the community who have helped others in a time of crisis and who consistently show an extraordinary gift for human compassion—the values and principles of the American Red Cross. Nominations must be received no later than May 14, 2010.

A nomination form is attached and additional forms are available at the American Red Cross, Southern Tier Chapter website (http://www.southerntierredcross.org). A panel of community leaders will review all "Heroes for the American Red Cross" nominations and select heroes in up to ten categories. The categories are: Adult Good Samaritan, Youth Good Samaritan, Good Neighbor, 911, Fire Rescue, Law Enforcement, Military, Education, Animal Rescue, Medical, Industrial Safety, and Blood Donor. Each nominee must reside in Broome, Chenango, Delaware, Otsego, or Tioga County; however, the heroic act may have occurred elsewhere. The heroic acts must have occurred within the past twenty-four months.

The breakfast will celebrate and honor each selected hero, and each hero will tell their story through video vignettes. Corporate sponsors will present each hero with their respective award. The Master of Ceremonies, from WBNG-TV, will lead the event.
