Understanding the ISO Fire Suppression Rating Schedule

- Origins and the historical perspective of the Fire Suppression Rating Schedule
- How the Public Protection Classification is used by the property insurance industry and its financial impact on property owners
- Review of the rating schedule including overview of Receiving and Handling of Alarms, Fire Department, and Water Supply
- Establishment of needed fire flows and their importance in the survey
- A detailed analysis of the items reviewed such as personnel, training, apparatus and equipment, water supply capabilities including flow testing, fire hydrant distribution and access
- Alternate water supply delivery methods including drafting locations and tanker shuttle operations
- Understanding how the rating schedule can fit into an overall risk management and fire defense planning strategy
