TRAINING FOR RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS AWARENESS

Approximately 144 truck loads of radioactive rods will be transported via Interstate 81 from Canada to Southeastern US during 2013. Although the risk is considered low, the Department of Energy is offering radioactive response awareness training to all counties along the corridor in preparation. This training is beneficial for all responses involving radioactive materials including what you might find on your local freight carrier.

We will offer a series of ten 8 hour awareness level classes beginning January 22nd both days and evenings at the Binghamton Fire Training Facility on Belden St, Binghamton, through February 1st.

In addition, we will offer one 16 hour more detailed course February 23 and 24th at the Broome County Public Safety Facility.
