Endicott Takes Delivery of New Sutphen Quint

Endicott Quint 25



The Village of Endicott Fire Department recently took delivery of a new Quint. The truck is a 2013 Sutphen SA 75' with a 1500 GPM pump and 500 gallon water tank. The truck is powered by a 450hp Cummings motor with an Allison 6 speed automatic transmission. The truck was purchased through sales rep Randy Shear from Vander Molen Fire Apparatus in Malta, NY.

This truck will serve to replace an aging 1986 LTI 100' Platform on a Spartan Chassis. It will also take the front line place of the truck formerly known as Squad 25 which is Saulsbury on a Spartan Chassis. In doing so the Genesis hydraulic extrication tools will be moved to Quint 25. Each of the four Platoons spent a day training with a Sutphen representative and learned how to operate the new rig.



Quint 25 made its maiden emergency voyage on May 13th, 2014 in response to an MVA with injury and entrapment at the intersection of Monroe St and Harrison Ave in the village.
