Greater Binghamton Airport is proud to be implementing an Open House style training program for mutual aid fire companies that support the Airport. These open houses will be scheduled on Mondays to coincide with department's usual training schedule. Each event will start at 7:20p to allow time for travel.

The schedule is as follows:

June 20th- **New Construction**. The wash building on airport property will be shown so agencies called to this facility will be familiar with the hazards inside, such as mechanical washing equipment which may injure employees, storage of chemicals, electrical systems, and fuel pumps and shut downs. We will also be showing the Shea Drive staging.

July 18th- Terminal Tour. Familiarization with fire suppression and alarm systems, access, and elevator rescue. Tower tour and access may be added depending on work load of ATC.

August 22nd- Crash Fire Rescue tour. Radios, access to facility, and crash truck familiarization.

Airport Employee schedules currently do not go beyond August 22nd, but more tours will be scheduled in the future including runway and taxiway familiarization, hangar facilities, and maintenance buildings.
